Olympic medalist Kendall Coyne to address student winners, and their families

Coyne, a suburban Chicago native, attended Carl Sandburg High School in Orland Park, Illinois and Northeastern University in Boston, Massachusetts where she earned both bachelor's and master's degrees. She will address the sixteen winners, their families, CNH Industrial executives and staff during a special awards ceremony at the Chicago Marriott Southwest in Burr Ridge, Illinois. Coyne will discuss perseverance both on and off the ice, determination in the classroom and share with the students how she overcame obstacles to attain her goals and reach her Olympic dreams.
